Photos can be colour or black and white photos and should be sent by email to <u>vietnamwaterexhibition</u> <u>@gmail.com</u>. *Original* photos should have a resolution suitable for printing in A2 size (at least 3840x2160 px). Size of the *sent sample* photos should be 3MB; only the selected photos will be required to be sent in original size upon notification! Participants are required to send a short description of their photos (3-5 sentences) and a short introduction on themselves preferably in English. Maximum 3 photos by participant will be accepted.

Deadline of the contest: 15 September 2016. Announcement of results: 30 September 2016. The best photos will be selected by the representatives of the organizing Embassies, VAPA and MoNRE.

The best 20 photos will be awarded a certificate and will be presented at an exhibition during October – November 2016 in Vietnam, in Bulgaria, in the Czech Republic, in Hungary, in Poland, in Romania and in Slovakia at high level international events with participation of state leaders and leaders of international organizations.* Photographers will not be awarded by other prize.
